Additional Consideration:

For a club in District 6900 the District requires the sum of the 4 year Annual Fund - Share giving average (3 years if there is an outlier/anamoly year) AND the new/additional money (or 50% of the approved DDF).

Conclusion:

Therefore, at the end of Rotary Year 2026, June 30th, Total Annual Fund - SHARE Giving for the club must be at least \$12,163 + \$7,834 = **\$19,997**

*Special Note: All contributions to the Annual Fund - SHARE from all the clubs in D6900 are all tallied each year. Three years later, 47.5% of that amount is returned to the District. (It used to be 50% until the last year or so). This money is what the District Foundation Committee administers. The 2 biggest uses of these funds are District Grants and DDF for Global Grants. For prospective D6900 gives +/- \$1mm annually, so the District typically has +/- \$450,000 to work with. The \$7,834 must be go to the Rotary Annual Fund -Share since in 3 years Rotary International will send 47.5%, \$3,721, back to District 6900. For this reason District 6900 must approve and will track the amount the club contributes for the Global Grant. If we were to send the money, \$7,834, to RI specifically for the global grant, it would not follow this matching process of the Annual Fund -Share. The \$1,500 contribution from the Paraguay Rotary club is not a significant factor for District 6900 to track since it will not go to the Annual Fund - Share, however that amount must be paid before the Rotary Foundation will release the total \$30,900 for the project.
