**Johnny Fulmer** introduced visiting Rotarians and guests while conducting the Carithers Scholarship raffle.



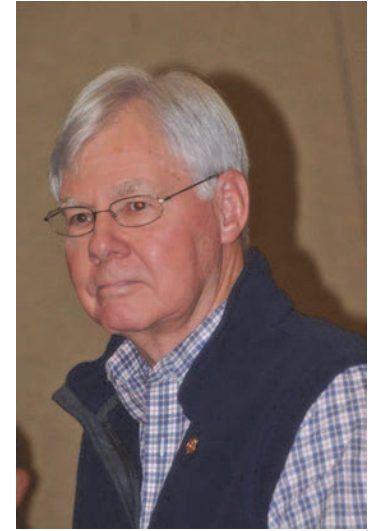
**Ben Frye** won a Church Street Market gift basket in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.
